

New Cart Placement Guidelines

George Leck and Son, Inc. will begin collecting garbage and recycling using automated refuse trucks in phases during the fall of 2011. These trucks allow our driver to empty residential trash and recycling carts into the trucks using a mechanical arm controlled from the cab of the truck.

Since this type of automated truck needs extra room to maneuver, we ask that you note the following guidelines below, regarding your cart placement at the curb.

Please place your cart no closer than 5 feet from other carts, your recycling cart, mailboxes or parked vehicles. Carts must be curbside and no further than 3 feet from the street in order to be serviced. Please do not place any extra garbage or recycling material against or on top of the carts. See photo illustration below.

Please be sure to always have your trash and/or recycle cart at the curbside by 6:00 AM on your regularly scheduled day to guarantee pick up.

Keep Carts At Least 14 Feet Away From:
Low Hanging Trees or Shrubs
